Rules for the request of examining boards for the defense of master's

thesis and doctoral dissertation.

The Collegiate of the Graduate Program in Mechanical Sciences establishes the following rules for

the request of composition of examining boards for the defense of master's and doctorate works.

Art. 1. General rules for the formation of final examining boards for master's and doctorate must follow

the determinations in resolution CEPE N. 0080/2017 and Regulation of PPG-CM, approved on

23/11/2018.

Art. 2. For his/her master's thesis defense, the student must prove the publication of a full paper in

annals of national ou international congress or the publication or ultimate acceptance of a paper in a

scientific journal indexed to the bases SCOPUS under a percentage equal to or above 50% assessed on

the date of the paper submission.

Art. 3. For his/her doctoral dissertation defense, the student must prove the publication of a full

paper in scientific journal indexed to the bases SCOPUS under a percentage equal to or above 50%

assessed on the date of the paper submission.

Art. 4. Omission situations will be examined by the Comission of the Graduate Program in

Mechanical Sciences.
